


Why Newberry? Simply put, it's a little accessible gem that's Southern to its core, and we mean that in a good way. Drive to Newberry on I-26. It's about 45 minutes west of Columbia, and about an hour east of Greenville.



Step Inside. This beauty is permanently moored in one enchanting Carolina coastal town. Veterans come to pay homage; youngsters love to scamper through its many levels.

A Spicy Sauce With a Confusing Name. In 1929, in Winston-Salem, Sam Garner and his three sons, Thad, Ralph and Harold, wanted to find the perfect name for the spicy sauce they'd just created.



Today, this saucy combination of vinegar and peppers is used to spice up everything from burgers to scrambled eggs. And it's still family-owned and made in Winston-Salem, North Carolina.

Carolina Grown. Although daylily flowers last only a day (the genus Hemerocallis comes from the Greek hēmera which means "day" and kallos means "beauty"), these no-fuss no-muss herbaceous perennials are the workhorses of the landscape.



Joy in the Morning. Daylilies provide a rainbow of flower colors that range from near-whites, pastels, yellows, oranges, pinks, vivid reds, crimson, purple, nearly true-blue, and fabulous blends.

With over 58,000 cultivars of daylilies, you're bound to find one that you like. There are selections with semidouble and double flowers.

Daylilies need about six hours of sunlight each day, although they will tolerate light shade but will produce fewer flowers.
